Making Life Count: Sharing from Shirley

We have been privileged to have Shirley Davidson serve as chairman on the local committee of CEF® of MARCK after having already served countless hours with fundraising and other roles on our local committee for 17 years. Shirley has formerly served as Director of Children's Ministry for Ashland Grace Brethren and Berean Baptist for a total of 13 years, along with serving as the Berean Moppets

Director. She volunteered with various roles at Mansfield Christian School for five years. Shirley presently is a client advocate and parenting class teacher at Richland Pregnancy Services. The following is a window into her life and encounter with the Lord and with Child Evangelism Fellowship.

I am passionate about Jesus Christ and Child Evangelism Fellowship. Because I have learned how valuable a story is to help others see the result of CEF, I share my story. As a little girl living in a middle-class neighborhood in the 1950s, I had the privilege of having a mother who was a fairly new Christian starved for the Word of God and desiring that her two daughters know the Jesus she had found. My sister, mother, grandmother, and I regularly attended church on Sundays where I heard the Bible stories, but it was at a neighborhood Good News Club® that I first heard how those stories related to my life. It was at this GNC® that I realized I was a sinner in need of a Savior. I heard the gospel clearly and repeti-

tively the story: DARK

through Wordless Book--a book of colors that tell salvation

page represented the darkness of sin.

RED represented the blood of Jesus that could make it possible for those sins to

be forgiven through Him,

CLEAN PAGE represented a clean heart that had believed the truth of God's Word and received Jesus,

GOLD represented heaven where the streets are made of gold and the place of my eternal home with Jesus, and

GREEN represented growing in Jesus through Bible reading, prayer, and fellowship.

When I made the decision to believe, I wanted others to know about Jesus, too, so they would have an opportunity to go to heaven. The Bible tells us God gives us spiritual gifts to be used for His purpose and His glory, and I believe mine is teaching. When I was eight years old, I gathered my neighborhood friends who did not attend the GNC and retold the stories I had heard with the flannelgraph materials my mother would purchase for

During the high school years of my life, I was very involved in the ministry of Youth for Christ having the privilege of being led by a very special director. Our public school had a Bible Club during the lunch hour that sometimes had 100 attendees. I continued to share the gospel with my classmates and friends using the Wordless Book.

Years later, after marrying my high school sweetheart and having three daughters, I shared the Wordless Book to countless clients at our local crisis pregnancy center, sometimes having the opportunity to lead a young woman to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. I became a speaker for Christian Women's Clubs using the Wordless Book as part of my testimony. I have often been told my words were among the clearest presentation of the gospel that the ladies had heard and on occasion learned of the fruit on my

Because I came to know Jesus at a young age--praise God, even a child can understand--I grew up avoiding many of the temptations that youth experienced at that time. I have been blessed to have a life of growing in Jesus.


